

Goldwater Bids Nixon Cooperate

Sen. Barry M. Goldwater (R-Ariz.) said yesterday President Nixon should "cooperate to the fullest extent" in the Watergate investigation to get the scandal behind him and get on with leading the country.

Goldwater said, "I think the Watergate has gone on long enough. I think the American people generally agree . . . that this country is in real

trouble and Watergate is not part of that trouble."

*Goldwater was among the strongest early critics of the administration's handling of Watergate.
