

Maryland Bar Unit Weighs Action on Agnew

The Baltimore County Bar Association is investigating the possibility of disciplinary action against former Vice President Spiro T. Agnew because of his conviction for income tax evasion.

William S. Baldwin, association president, said yesterday results of the investigation will be kept secret until the group's executive board decides whether to go to court.

If the association's grievance committee recommends some disciplinary action against Agnew and the executive board concurs, a formal complaint would be heard by a three-judge panel. It then would be sent to the state Court of Special Appeals for a final ruling.
