knew about Hughes gift?

LOS ANGELES — A source close to Herbert Kalmbach, President Nixon's former personal attorney, said Kalmbach knew of a \$100,000 donation from Howard Hughes to Nixon's campaign, according to the Los Angeles Times.

The source said Kalmbach did not tell Nixon about the donation because he thought there was nothing unusual about it, the Times said today.

Las Vegas publisher Hank Greenspun recently described what he knew about the contribution. The money allegedly was given to Nixon confidant C. G. "Bebe" Rebozo in \$100 bills in 1969. Rebozo has said he kept the money three years, then returned it to Hughes.
