The FBI is said to be investigating the disappearance of confidential files on a Florida savings and loan association run by associates of Bebe Rebozo, who in turn is a good friend of President Nixon. The Baltimore Sun reported today that the documents on the Key Biscayne Bank are missing from the offices of the Federal Home Loan Bank Board. It just so happens that the House Banking Committee, chaired by congressman Jack Brooks of Texas, wanted to see those files to determine if the administration was giving special treatment to Rebozo's business interests. The files in question detail how the federal government decided to grant the Rebozo bank federal insurance after twice turning it down. According to the Baltimore Sun, it now turns out that the files are missing and the FBI has been called in to investigate.
