*Nixons Watch a Film
After a Day of Crisis*

WASHINGTON, Oct. 21 (UPI) — While the White House was announcing the departure of chief Justice Department officials, the Nixon family was watching a movie entitled "The Searching Wind."

The President and Mrs. Nixon first had dinner with their daughter and son-in-law, Julie and David Eisenhower, and two close family friends, Charles G. Rebozo and Rosemary Woods, Mr. Nixon's personal secretary for more than 20 years.

The family dined in the upstairs family quarters and then went down to the White House theater after a day of Presidential crisis over the Watergate tapes and the Middle East war.
