Nixon Has A Talk With Richardson

President Nixon met for a half-hour yesterday with Elliot L. Richardson, who resigned as attorney general in the Watergate tapes dispute, the White House said.

However, presidential spokesmen would not give any indication of what the meeting was about.

Deputy press secretary Gerald L. Warren said that Richardson talked by telephone yesterday with Mr. Nixon's chief of staff, Alexander M. Haig Jr., and the idea of a meeting with the President stemmed from their conversation.

"It came up in the conversation and they agreed he (Richardson) would come over and see the President," Warren said.
