

Impeachment resolutions in the House

WASHINGTON -- The House met for only four hours yesterday, but within that time eight resolutions calling for the impeachment of President Nixon were introduced.

Before the house adjourned, the resolutions had picked up 31 cosponsors, members who wish to have their names added to a bill in the official record.

In addition, 13 resolutions calling for a committee of inquiry to look into the question of whether impeachable charges had been committed — a preliminary step before actual impeachment proceedings — were introduced in the same time and gathered 76 cosponsors.
