Impeachment resolutions in the House

WASHINGTON — The House met for only four hours yesterday, but within that time eight resolutions calling for the impeachment of President Nixon were introduced.

Before the house a djourned, the resolutions had picked up 31 cosponsors, members who wish to have their names added to a bill in the official record.

In addition, 13 resolutions calling for a committee of inquiry to look into the question of whether impeachable charges had been committed — a preliminary step before actual impeachment proceedings — were introduced in the same time and gathered 76 cosponsors.
