

Rep. Ford, watching Mr. Nixon, found him to be 'strong but humble'

Ford 'Proud' of Nixon

Waukesha, Wis.

Vice President-designate Gerald Ford praised President Nixon's performance in a news conference last night as "superb."

"I was very proud of the President of the United States," Ford told a news conference here shortly before his address at a testimonial dinner for Representative Glenn Davis (Rep-Wis.), a long-time friend of Ford and Mr. Nixon. "I felt the President was strong but humble," he said.

In his 25 years in Congress, Ford said, he

could not recall a more difficult presidential session with the prass, and he added, "I thought the President was just superb."

On Mr. Nixon's proposal regarding appointment of a new special prosecutor in the Watergate case, Ford said he felt such a prosecutor could move "vigorously and effectively." He said, however, that such a special prosecutor should operate within "responsible guidelines."

"I also feel that the President has been harding over backwards to be geomerative." he

"I also feel that the President has been bending over backwards to be cooperative," he said of recent Watergate developments.
