Bush Sees No Chance

Of Nixon Resignation

BOSTON, Oct. 26 (AP)—George Bush, chairman of the Republican National Committee, said today that he could not envision any circumstances under which President Nixon would resign.

He termed requests for Mr. Nixon's resignation "indecent" and added, "At this time of great crisis—war and peace—we have a man who understands world politics, world power. This man deserves great cooperation, but because of the emotions of the moment he is not getting it."

On the question of impeachment, Mr. Bush told newsmen he thought the House should take no action, "and I'm convinced they won't take any."
