CAMP DAVID (Md.) — President Nixon and his family went over a stack of approving telegrams yesterday as the President relaxed at his mountain retreat after a week of domestic and international crisis, the White House said.

Deputy Press Secretary Gerald L. Warren said "well over 3000 telegrams" and thousands of telephone calls were received at the White House after the President's televised news conference Friday night.

They expressed sentiments "overwhelmingly in favor" of the statements Nixon made in the 39-minute session, Warren said.
