## On Impeachment

The chairman of the Marin county Board of Supervisors abstained from voting to urge impeachment of President Nixon yesterday, leaving the board in a 2 to 2 tie.

But Chairman Arnold Baptiste told an audience of some 100 Marin residents who attended a 90-minute impeachment forum that he will vote in favor of the impeachment resolution in two weeks if he hears from enough Marin voters.

The supervisors' indecisive vote followed the forum, during which speakers called for the scalp of the President by a margin of at least eight to one.

Ultimately voting to urge impeachment were Supervisors Gary Giacomini and Michael Wornum. Peter Arrigoni and Robert Roumiguere were against.
