Cox to Lecture

At Cambridge

CAMBRIDGE, England, Oct. 31 (AP)—Archibald Cox, fired by President Nixon as special Watergate prosecutor, has been named a visiting Cambridge University professor.

The university said today that Cox will be Pitt professor of American history and institutions beginning next October.

A spokesman said the appointment does not mean that Cox, a law professor at Harvard, must leave the United States for an extended period. He is required only to visit Cambridge at least once to deliver a lecture or course of lectures.
