Agnew Pays His Fine; Baltimore Gets Check

BALTIMORE, Oct. 31 (UPI)

—A \$10,000 personal check from former Vice President Spiro T. Agnew was received at the United States Attorney's office in Baltimore today to pay a fine imposed on Mr. Agnew for income tax evasion.

United States Attorney George Beall said he had received the check in today's mail and it was turned over to the Clerk of Courts in Baltimore.

The check was dated Oct. 28. Mr. Agnew pleaded no contest to a charge of income tax evasion in Baltimore Federal court Oct. 10 and was fined \$10,000 and put on three year probation.

He resigned the Vice-Presidency the same day.
