

ABA Head Urges Court Named Prosecutor

Washington

Chesterfield Smith, president of the American Bar Association, said he respects Leon Jaworski, newly named special Watergate prosecutor, but there still is a need for a court-appointed Watergate prosecutor.

Smith made his comments after testifying before a House Judiciary subcommittee hearing.

In his testimony, Smith said President Nixon had "violated basic principles of justice" in restricting former special prosecutor Cox's access to basic investigatory material.
