Nixon Flies Hastily
to Key Biscayne

President Nixon flew to Key Biscayne yesterday afternoon for a weekend of relaxation.

Deputy Press Secretary Gerald Warren said that White House chief of staff

Alexander M. Haig Jr. and press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler arranged to join the President at Key Biscayne later in the day.

The President left in such a hurry that members of the press pool were unable to get to Andrews Air Force Base in time to travel with him. The press plane followed behind the presidential jet.

Mr. Nixon is expected to return to Washington Sunday night or Monday, according to Warren.
