

Russians Learn Of Attempts to Impeach Nixon

Moscow

The Soviet press, which once shunned any discussion of the Watergate scandal, has begun carrying reports of moves to impeach President Nixon for his possible involvement in the case.

The Soviet weekly New Times mentioned yesterday for what is believed to be the first time in any of the government-controlled journals that draft resolutions calling for Mr. Nixon's impeachment have been discussed in Congress.

The account was a straightforward report of latest developments in the Watergate case and was part of what observers see as a greater effort by the Soviet media to inform the public of the seriousness of the scandal and Mr. Nixon's position.
