Betty Friedan Urges Drive to Impeach Nixon

Women's liberationist Betty Friedan called upon the nation's women yesterday to "mobilize immediately" in a campaign urging Congress to move for impeachment of President Nixon. "I call of the women of this country to take action now to save the nation," she said at a press conference in the St. Francis Hotel here. Ms. Friedan author of "The Feminine Mystique" and founder of the National Organization for Women (NOW), was in San Francisco to address a meeting of the Bank Administration Institute. But she hastily organized the news conference to urge women to "join together in the face of this emergency..." "If the men don't act, the women of this country will," she said. "Congress will do what the people tell them to do—and women make up 53 per cent of our adult population." "There is no way for us to be liberated if we lose our democracy."
