## Bar president calls for tapes

HONOLULU — Chesterfield Smith, president of the America Bar Association, said that President Nixon should abandon his stand on executive privilege in connection with the Watergate tapes.

If Nixon had a valid argument on executive privilege,

"it was destroyed by the inept way it was handled," Smith said.

He said the overriding concern now is that the public confidence in government be restored.
