Nixon Cables Kissinger

And Returns to Capital

WASHINGTON, Nov. 11 (AP) —President Nixon returned to the White House today from Camp David after cabling congratulations to Secretary of State Kissinger on the Middle East peace agreement.

Mr. Nixon's helicopter left the closely guarded compound in Maryland's Cotoctin Mountains on such short notice that newsmen were unable to watch it take off, as they customarily do.

A White House spokesman said that a memorandum Mr. Nixon dictated to Mr. Kissinger included further instructions for his current talks in Peking. The spokesman said Mr. Nixon returned here shortly after noon and went to his Oval Office to work.
