

CBS to Comment Promptly on Nixon

CBS will go back to analyzing presidential speeches immediately after they are delivered, CBS chairman William S. Paley said yesterday.

On June 6, shortly after the White House publicly complained about what it called unfair "instant" analyses, CBS said it would delay any comment until the regularly scheduled newscast following a presidential address.

NBC and ABC continued to provide analyses immediately after such speeches.

"Since June 6," Paley said in a statement, "the nation and the world have witnessed a rapid series of exceptionally newsworthy events. This has made it clear that postponing news analyses under all circumstances may impair a journalistic service of far greater value to the public than we had realized."
