

Fourth Senator Calls on Nixon To Resign

Senator Philip Hart (Dem-Mich) yesterday called on President Nixon to "resign with grace."

"If he hands in his resignation with a litany of grievances, it would do a great disservice to the country," Hart told a news conference.

"On the other hand," he said, "if the President should resign with grace it might be the best way to bring us out of the (Watergate) situation which is extremely difficult right now."

Hart became the fourth senator to urge Mr. Nixon to leave office. Calls for his resignation have come from Senators Daniel Inouye (Dem-Hawaii), John Tunney (Dem-Calif.) and Edward Brooke (Rep-Mass.)
