## Nixon's Popularity Slide Levels at $27 \%$

President's approval rating had declined steadily since mid-August, when his rating stood at 38 per cent ap. proval.
The current rating represents a drop of 41 pereentage points from Mr. Nixon's high point of 68 per cent approval, recorded in a survey taken following the Vietnam peace settlement in January. Following is the question
asked to determine approval or disapproval of the incumbent President since the Roosevelt years:
Do you approve or disap. prove of the way Mr. Nixon is handing his job as President?
Here are the national find ings, with the trend since mid-August:


All persons in the latest survey were also asked to indicate how strongly they approve or disapprove of Mr. Nixon's handling of his job.
The results show only 15 per cent of the total sample
approving strongly. In contrast, about three times as many, 44 per cent, say they disapprove strongly.
