HARTFORD, Nov. 19 (AP)—
The Hartford Courant, the nation's oldest newspaper of continuous daily publication in America, changed its editorial view yesterday and called for the impeachment of President Nixon.

Noting that one month ago the paper opposed calls for impeachment, The Courant said, "In the subsequent weeks, however, the whole situation has only become more muddled and confused, wracking and riving the country and the citizens to a point of complete distraction."

The editorial continued: "This has got to stop. The miasma enveloping the nation and the Presidency has got to be cleared up now without being allowed to drag its weary length any further."
