

Supreme Court Bars

Liddy From Practicing

WASHINGTON, Nov. 19 (AP)—In a routine order today, the Supreme Court suspended Watergate conspirator G. Gordon Liddy from practicing law before the Justices.

As is usual in such cases, the Court issued an order requiring Liddy to show cause within 40 days why he should not be barred from practicing law before the high court.

Liddy, 43 years old, was sentenced in March to from six years and eight months to 20 years in prison for his part in the Watergate break-in. He is serving a shorter sentence for contempt of court.
