## Crash Involving Mrs. Hunt Ruled Accidental by a Jury

Ruled Accidental by a Jury

CHICAGO, Nov. 21 (AP)—A
Cook County coroner's jury
ruled Wednesday that the death
of Mrs. E. Howard Hunt Jr. and
44 other persons in a plane
crash near Midway Airport last
December was accidental.
Eighteen persons were injured and four homes were destroyed when the United Air
Lines jet, on a flight from
Washington, crashed into a
residential area on its approach
to Midway.

Mrs. Hunt, whose husband
was one of seven men convicted
in the Watergate burglary, had
been carrying \$10,000 in cash
aboard the plane.

Her death led to speculation
that the plane had been sabotaged because of her presence;
but Federal, aviation specialists
ruled after an investigation
there was no evidence of sabotage. The coroner's jury deliberated for 12 minutes.
