

'Honor pledge on alert'

WASHINGTON — Sen. William Proxmire, (D-Wis.) yesterday called on Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger to honor his pledge and make public the facts about the U.S. military alert ordered during the Middle East crisis.

Proxmire said Kissinger,

at an Oct. 25 press conference, promised to disclose the reasons for the alert.

But Kissinger, at another press conference last Wednesday, said he regretted making the promise and added that it would serve no useful purpose to reveal the reasons for the worldwide troop alert.
