New Report On Nixon's Pneumonia

New York

President Nixon's attack of viral pneumonia, which put him into Bethesda Naval Hospital for nine days in July, was more serious than White House bulletins had indicated, Newsweek magazine said yesterday.

Newsweek's current issue reports that a top official says that Mr. Nixon was coughing blood before going to Bethesda and that his condition "scared hell" out of his White House visitor.
