

Egil Krogh Trial Set

Washington

Former White House aide Egil Krogh will go on trial December 11 on charges he lied under oath about the burglary by the White House "plumbers" at the California office of Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist.

U.S. District Judge Gerhard A. Gesell said yesterday he expects the jury trial to last about a week.

Krogh, who headed the secret plumbers unit at the White House, has accepted responsibility but contended that he was acting lawfully in defense of national security.
