## WXPost NDV 2 8 1973 Richardson Urges Panel Quiz of Nixon

Former Attorney General Elliot L. Richardson said last night that President Nixon should submit to questioning on the Watergate scandal by a panel of "knowledgeable people who can crossexamine him and ask follow-up questions."

Richardson said on the Dick Cavett television show that the panel might include Sens. Sam J. Erwin Jr. (D-N.C.) and Howard R. Baker (R-Tenn.), chairman and vice chairman, respectively, of the Senate Watergate committee, and Special Prosecutor Leon Jaworski, who would quiz the President "under the auspices of a neutral moderator." Richardson suggested that Sen. John C. Stennis (D-Miss.) might be the moderator.
