

Watergate Jury Gets Another Year

Washington

President Nixon signed into law yesterday a bill extending the life of the Watergate grand jury for up to one year. It would have expired Tuesday without the special legislation.

The bill provides for a six-month extension of the grand jury beyond its normal, 18-month life span, and allows an additional six month extension to Dec. 4, 1974, at the discretion of Judge John J. Sirica.
