Dwight L. Chapin, the former appointments secretary for President Nixon, will be arraigned at 9:30 a.m. Friday before U.S. District Judge Gerhard A. Gesell.

Chapin was indicted Thursday on four counts of lying to a federal grand jury probing the activities of political saboteur Donald Segretti.

The former White House aide took a leave of absence from his current employer, United Airlines, while defending himself against the charges, the company said.
