**LEAKS FROM STAFF
DENIED BY JAWORSKI**

WASHINGTON, Dec. 2 (UPI) — Leon Jaworski, the special Watergate prosecutor, denied Sunday a White House aide's charge that members of his staff had leaked information to the press.

Replying to charges made by the White House press secretary, Ronald L. Ziegler, he said: "Without entering a debate over the subject of leaks, I want to state that I have complete confidence that my office has not disclosed any investigative material concerning any individual or any case, and I understand that the individual who made that charge, who said he was not speaking for the White House but personally, has since said he has no facts in the case and that he regrets raising the question if it is wrong."

Mr. Jaworski was interviewed by the magazine U.S. News & World Report.
