Senate Votes \$500,000 More For Watergate

The Senate yesterday voted an additional \$500,000—making a total of \$1.5 million—for its investigation into the Watergate scandals.

A resolution providing the \$500,000 for the special senate Watergate committee was approved by voice vote.

Chairman Sam J. Ervin Jr. (Dem-N.C.) requested the funds, saying they are needed to finish the committee's mission. He said he hoped the investigation would be completed before expiration of the Senate's mandate February 28.
