

FBI, Watergate Men Hurt in Melee

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 6, Reuter—An FBI agent, a Senate Watergate committee investigator and an 18-year-old youth were wounded today in a melee on the steps of the Federal Building.

The violence began when FBI agent Tom Hopkins and George Session of San Fran-

cisco apparently bumped into each other.

After an exchange of words, U.S. Attorney James Browning said, Session pulled a knife and slashed the agent about the throat.

Hopkins fired his gun, the bullet creased Session's chest, ricocheted, and hit Carl Rizer,

57, in the leg. Rizer, a former Internal Revenue Service agent, is working for the Senate Watergate committee.

Session was subdued by two deputy U.S. marshals who were returning from lunch.

All three sustained only superficial wounds.
