Grand Jury Bid Of Gurney Weighed

grand jury in Miami.
Gurney (R.Fla.) made
the offer during a statewide television news conference Thursday night
when he defended himself
against charges that he
knew of illegal campaign
fund-raising in his name.
The jury is investigating allegations that Larry
E. Williams, 29, of Orlando, pressured Florida
builders into making campaign donations to Gurney, in return for a promise of help in getting Federal Housing Administration contracts.
