
Shapp Intends to Seek Re-election

HARRISBURG, Pa., Dec. 10 (AP)—Gov. Milton J. Shapp announced today his intention to seek re-election. He said that even Democrats like himself must overcome Watergate.

nimself must overcome watergate.
"I think Watergate caused a lessening in the feeling of security that people have in their institutions and trust for elected officials," Mr. Shapp said. "This applies to

both parties." The Governor, who is 61 years old, said he must convince voters next year that his administration was honest, open and concerned for the little man.

He is the first Governor of Pennsylvania in 100 years who will be permitted to succeed himself. A constitutional ban that prevented his predecessors from doing so was lifted in 1967.
