Like Dean

Barcelona

A group of Spanish newspaper directors polled by the Spanish weekly newsmagazine Mundo have voted former U.S. White House counsel John Dean, "Man of the Year of 1973."

Dean, who testified against President Nixon in the Watergate scandal, received 60 votes. U.S. Secretary of State Henry Kissinger was second with 57 votes. Argentinian President Juan Peron received 44 votes, just ahead of Dutch rugby star Johann Cruyff.
