A helicopter chartered by Robert L. Vesco's company Harry L. Sears, former carried former White House chairman of the presidential aide Harry S. Dent to cam-paign appearances for President Nixon in New Jersey last year, according to re-cords collected for a federal

investigation.

Despite an assertion by chairman of the presidential re-election campaign in New Jersey, that his committee paid for flight. helicopter records show that the International Controls Corp. Them headed by Vesco, paid for the charter. Corporations are barred by law from contributing money or services to political campaigns.

The use of the helicopter by Dent - among some other prominent figures, including apparently a brother and

nephew of Nixon - emerged in a study of the helicopter's records by new officers and representatives of Internaional Controls who are trying to trace the company's tangled finances.
