Nixon Weighs Trip

By Train to Florida

President Nixon is considering the possibility of traveling by train to Key Biscayne, Fla., for a week or more of rest after Christmas.

Officials insisted yesterday that no decision has been made about the trip, but they acknowledged that train plans have been considered because of the fuel crisis. A presidential car would be attached to a regular scheduled passenger train between Washington and Miami.

The government discourages other officials from taking overnight train trips because the fare for a sleeper generally is substantially more than for a trip by plane.
