

Humphrey's Tax Break For Papers

Senator Hubert H. Humphrey (Dem-Minn.) claimed an income tax deduction for personal papers from his vice presidential years donated to the Minnesota State Historical Society, his office said yesterday.

An aide said Humphrey, vice president from 1965 to 1969, is preparing a complete report on the deduction to be released later this week.

Controversy has arisen over the timing of the deduction claimed by President Nixon for the donation papers covering his vice presidency from 1953 to 1961. The papers, appraised at \$576,000, were given to the National Archives.

Mr. Nixon was vice president from 1953 to 1961.
