

Ford to Fight Against Impeachment

Vice President Gerald R. Ford left yesterday evening for Madrid to attend the funeral of Spanish Premier Luis Carrero Blanco.

The White House said Ford, who left on a flight from Andrews Air Force Base, was designated as President Nixon's personal representative at the funeral today. He was accompanied by Undersecretary of State William J. Porter, a spokesman said.

Completing the U.S. funeral delegation will be Ambassador Horacio Rivero, already in Madrid, where Carrero Blanco was assassinated yesterday by an explosion that tore his car to bits.
