No Paper Shredder

### For Inquiry on Nixon

WASHINGTON, Dec. 20 (UPI)—The House Administration Committee, keeper of House supplies, has told the Judiciary Committee it may not have a Destroyit Superspeed paper shredder for its inquiry into possible impeachment of President Nixon.

Representative Wayne L. Hays, Democrat of Ohio, chairman of the Administration committee, turned down a request for the machine from the Judiciary Committee chairman, Representative Peter W. Rodino, Democrat of New Jersey.

"Reference is made to your request of Dec. 14, 1973 to purchase a 'Destroyit Superspeed' Series 52AM paper shredder for use by your committee," he wrote Mr. Rodino. "I have been under the impression that your committee was going to investigate paper shredding and possibly other activities hiding public business from the public rather than to obtain a shredder and shredding on its own. The request is not approved."
