

IRS Questions Source of Story On Nixon Taxes

Washington

The Internal Revenue Service said yesterday that a published report that it will soon rule that President Nixon underpaid his federal income tax "does not come from an authorized source."

The Knight Newspaper Service had said Tuesday that a special IRS task force "is prepared to report that Mr. Nixon should have paid capital gains taxes on the sale of part of his San Clemente estate to his friends, C. G. (Bebe) Rebozo and Robert Abplanalp."

IRS announced last week that an audit of the President's tax returns was under way.
