The Republican National Committee says Democrats got \$36,000 more in contributions from the milk industry last year than Republicans received.

"This analysis is clear evidence," said Republican national chairman George Bush, "that the popular notion — fed by Democrat propaganda — that Republicans are milking the dairy associations for all they are worth with the promise of special favors is sheer nonsense."

The committee's official magazine, First Monday, said its analysis showed Democrats got \$613,000 from four milk industry political organizations and Republicans including President Nixon got \$577,000. The magazine said its analysis of the four milk organizations' contributions to presidential, Senate and House campaigns was based on figures compiled by the magazine Congressional Quarterly on contributions of several industries.

The Republican magazine said two of the milk organizations, including the one President Nixon said last week he was told had pledged \$2 million to him, contributed more to Republicans than to Democrats.

But it said all four milk organizations contributed \$36,000 more to the Democrats than to Republicans.

The President denied in a white paper last week that milk producers' contributions influenced his order to increase milk price supports.
