

Gregorio Urges Nixon to Resign

Sacramento

State Senator Arlen Gregorio (Dem-San Mateo) introduced a resolution yesterday urging President Nixon to resign "for the good of the republic."

Gregorio said if the resolution passes the California Legislature "it just might bring home to President Nixon and those close to him, in a way nothing else apparently has, how far beyond any hope of political recovery his presidency has progressed."

Gregorio has no co-authors on the resolution and he frankly does not expect much action on the resolution until a public reac-

tion arises in response to it.

Gregorio said the main concern behind the resolution is that because of the Watergate scandals the Nixon presidency is eroding respect for elected representative government.

The joint resolution requires a simple majority to pass both the 40-seat Senate and the 80-member Assembly. Democrats control both houses, the Senate 21 to 19 and the Assembly 49 to 31.
