State of Union Message

Is Planned for Jan. 29

WASHINGTON, Jan. 17— President Nixon will deliver his State of the Union Message to Congress at 12:30 P.M., Eastern daylight time, on Jan. 29, the White House announced today.

Mr. Nixon's appearance at the joint Senate-House session will be available for television-radio broadcast.

Congressional sources said, meanwhile, that Mr. Nixon would submit his Budget Message to Congress on Jan. 30, and his Economic Message on Jan. 31.

Mr. Nixon plans additional Congressional messages next month on health insurance, education, veterans, natural resources and the environment, rural development, heroin trafficking and energy, they added.

The State of the Union Message had been planned for Jan. 23.
