

Ford: I won't seek GOP nomination

WASHINGTON — Vice President Ford and California Gov. Reagan shadow boxed last night over who will be the Republican nominee for President in 1976.

Ford indicated, however, he would not be running and told newsmen he doubted very much that it would be a Reagan-Ford combination.

"We're a good combination tonight," Ford said at the 39th annual Touchdown Club awards dinner.

Earlier, Reagan would not say whether he would be a candidate for the presidency, but told newsmen he was in the East to make a four-state speaking tour to raise funds for other Republicans.
