

Report Nixon's Gift of Papers Was Backdated

Government investigators have been told by two lawyers for President Nixon that the lawyers "backdated" his vice presidential papers to the National Archives in 1969, according to the current issue of Newsweek.

Newsweek said that Edward Morgan, a former White House deputy counsel, and Edward Demarco, a California lawyer and law partner of President Nixon's fund raiser, Herbert W. Kalmbach, have testified that the copy of the deed that was eventually sent to the archives was signed more than a year after the date that appears on it.
