

**State of the Union
Reset for Jan. 30**

President Nixon has decided to postpone his State of the Union address for one day because of a conflict with a long-scheduled congressional dinner, it was learned yesterday.

The President also scheduled meetings with congressional leaders today to brief them on developments in the Middle East.

Mr. Nixon had originally decided to deliver his State of the Union address personally to Congress on Jan. 29. At the request of Senate Republican Leader Hugh Scott, it was put off until Jan. 30. Both Scott and House Speaker Carl Albert (D-Okla.) are to attend a congressional dinner at the National Press Club.
